Rutte is the smallest distillery in Holland that happens to be partnered with one of the nation's largest distilleries, De Kuyper Royal Distillers. For 143 years Rutte has made its home in the historic port city of Dordrecht, The Netherlands. Their artisanal spirits are made entirely with natural ingredients. The **Rutte Celery Gin is delightfully unusual** with a pronounced celerly note. The botanicals used are: juniper, celery, coriander, angelica root, sweet orange peel, and cardamon.

TALKING POINTS



FROM RUTTE

The old world meets the new world with our Celery Gin. Generations of Rutte distilling methods, along with some of our new recipes, come together to create this signature flavor.

IN THE GLASS

Appearance: Brilliant, crystal clear.

Aromatics: The nose is rather delicate allowing the sweet scents of the pot still distillate to rise from the glass. The celery is certainly evident and it seems to accentuate the fruity notes of the juniper and the sweetness of the angelica with hints of spring flowers and citrus.

Flavor: The palate echoes the nose delivering soft, sweet herbal notes with vibrant citrus that finish with a touch of mint and cardamon.

Intensity & Texture: Medium-bodied with ideal balance and a beautiful complexity. The botanicals are pronounced while delicate with great length.
